- The checks and references will be carried out using an approved credit reference agency in strictest confidence and on the basis of information supplied in the Tenancy Application Form
- All personal information supplied to the Landlord or Agent shall be kept secure at all times and shall be permanently and securely destroyed when no longer required.
- Deposits shall be returned in full at the end of the tenancy period subject to the rules of any deposit protection scheme used and normal wear and tear. However, damage, cleaning and rubbish removal could result in deductions or claims for deductions from your deposit.
- The rental amount agreed must be paid in full and on-time as agreed up to and including the final period of the tenancy.
- By signing the tenancy agreement the tenant commits to paying rent for the full fixed term of the tenancy.
- False statements made could result in early termination of a tenancy under ground 17 Housing Act 1998
